#### Not So Strange

Apple devices may look and feel very different from the systems you and the IT staff are used to using and managing. #### **Different Tools?**

The possibilities for supporting Apple devices in the enterprise are on par with what is available for Windows based and mobile devices. Many malware and antivirus suites offer Mac agents. Some Windows based management suites offer limited support of OS X. Most Enterprise Mobility Management software supports iOS and OS X. But if we want full capabilities for both operating systems, additional software will be needed. This can be standalone tools like JAMF's Casper Suite or a plugin like Parallel's Mac Management for Microsoft SCCM.
