Day 1

Configuring and Monitoring OS X Server

Understand the requirements for OS X Server, installation, and initial configuration. Providing DNS, understanding SSL certificates, monitoring Server for OS X, and backing up server configuration and data.

Configuring Accounts

Managing local users and service access authorization, understanding and configuring Open Directory, working with local network accounts, and Kerberos.

Day 2

Managing Devices with Configuration Profiles Configuring Profile Manager, creating profiles, delivering profiles.

Sharing Files

Configure OS X Server to share files with iOS, OS X, and Windows. Understanding POSIX and ACL permissions.

Day 3

Implementing Deployment Solutions

Understanding NetBoot, NetInstall, and NetRestore, creating images, configuring clients to use NetInstall. Caching content from Apple, providing software updates.

Providing Network Services

Understanding the Time Machine service, securing communications with VPN, providing DHCP and, hosting multiple web sites on a single server.

Using Collaborative Services

Setting up and configuring wikis and blogs, providing iChat and iCal services, configuring Address Book service to share contact information, and providing mail services.

Students can take the OS X Server Essentials 10.10 exam - one of two exams required for Apple Certified Technical Coordinator (ACTC) 10.10 certification.
