Acceptance Date

Acceptance is upon receipt. The Government reserves the right to inspect or test any supplies or services that have been tendered for acceptance. The Government may require repair or replacement of nonconforming supplies or re-performance of nonconforming services at no increase in contract price. The Government must exercise its post-acceptance rights— (1) within a reasonable time after the defect was discovered (usually considered to be 30 days); and (2) before any substantial change occurs in the condition of the item, unless the change is due to the defect in the item.

Product Returns

In accordance with FAR Part 52.212-4, the Government may require repair or replacement of nonconforming supplies or re-performance of nonconforming services at no increase in contract price. The Government must exercise its post-acceptance rights--(1) Within a reasonable time after the defect was discovered or should have been discovered (within 30 days); and (2) before any substantial change occurs in the condition of the items, unless the change is due to the defect in the item. If an item is ordered in error, customer is required to pay for any shipping fees incurred for the return and may be subject to a restocking fee (normally 15% of item returned).
